**Re: London 2012 Paralympic Games list of events and Minimum Qualification Standard (MQS)**

Dear NPC Representatives,

It is our pleasure to present you the 2012 Paralympic Games list of events and MQS, two years before the highest level competition in the Paralympic Movement.

The methodology for selecting the events were announced some months ago, they can be found on the website, and based on these you will find the list of events for the 2012 Paralympic Games programme on the last pages of this document.

We would like to draw your attention to the following matters:

- After careful consideration the women's S1 class has not been allocated an event. This is due to not having enough athletes on the rankings in any of the events.
- The MQS is based on the average result of the 12-14<sup>th</sup> ranked swimmers on the World ranking 2009-2010; when this was not possible due to a low number of swimmers on the ranking, the average of 8-10<sup>th</sup> ranked swimmers was calculated.
- Reaching the MQS does **NOT** mean that a swimmer will be accepted for the Paralympic Games automatically. If the number of swimmers on the World rankings reaching MQS outnumber the available slots, the process described in the 2012 London Qualification Guide will be implemented to allocate slots to each NPC. It is then the NPC's decision to identify which swimmer(s) will participate in the Games.
- To enhance the depth of competition in the heats at the Paralympic Games, a Minimal Entry Time (MET) is introduced. Swimmers who already received a slot through reaching at least one MQS, can enter other events if MET is reached.  
MET is based on the 20<sup>th</sup> or 15<sup>th</sup> place of the World ranking 2009-2010 depending on the depth of the ranking.



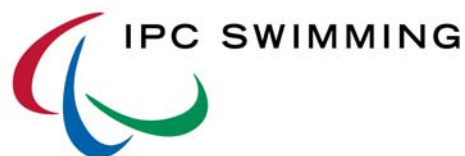
- A decision was also taken to align the male-female ratio to reflect the qualification rankings, and that lead to a conclusion to have 340 male slots and 260 female slots at the London 2012 Paralympic Games.

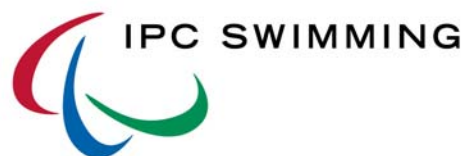

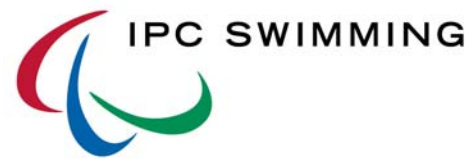
